- 2. Pledge of Allegiance
- 3. Roll Call- Maddocks, Farmer, Cesaretti, Nunes. Also present: Chief Bullard, Assistant Chief Sabrowsky

- 6. Old Business

a. Status on Engineer and Firefighter positions - Received 16 applications internally and externally. Confirming interview panel to move ahead in process.

b. COVID-19 Response & Protection - Return to in-person training in the field and bay. Using protocols in place for social distancing, cleaning, etc.

c. Station Refinancing: Brandis Tallman followed up with refinancing discussion from last month. They distributed a Lender Request for Proposal to 15 banks and received 3 quotes with interest rates at 19-year, 17, and 15-year terms. Capital One presented the best proposal at a 15-Year Term with a total Cash Flow Savings of \$360,839 at a Net Present Value Savings of 5.95%.

i. Consider and adopt Debt Policy: Motion to accept Debt Policy as written. Nunes moves. Cesaretti 2nds. Passed 4-0-1.

ii. Consider and approve Resolution 20-6-1. Nunes makes motion to approve Resolution and select Capital One's 15-year proposal for the refunding of the prior COPs. Farmer 2nds. Passed 4-0-1.

iii. Nunes moves for Brandis Tallman to work with Capital One and Special Counsel to finalize the lease documents. The financing team will also work with USDA to close on July 1, 2020 and pay off the Prior COPs. Farmer 2nds. Passed 4-0-1.

d. November Re-Election for Torrey Farmer, Wes Gray, and Jason Nunes. Documents are accepted electronically. Pitts supplied links to resources for candidates.

e. Mutual/Auto Aid Calls. Bullard reached out to County Fire, they are willing to pay for the service. Bullard presented a proposal to reimburse. Board decided the mutual aid calls are not about funding but resources responding out of district. Board directed staff to discontinue mutual aid.
