This communication sets forth reportable action of the Board of Directors ("Board") of the Graton Fire Protection District ("District") consistent with provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Opening Meeting Act (Government Code Section 54950, *et seq.*) resulting from the Closed Session of the June 13, 2023 Regular Board Meeting.

After convening in Open Session at 7:00 p.m. and after concluding the matters agendized for Open Session consideration and determining that there were no public comments on matters agendized for Closed Session consideration, the Board adjourned to Closed Sessions (4–0, Director Fisher absent) at 7:31 p.m. District Counsel Ross suggested, and the Board approved, that two additional items would be added for Board consideration to Closed Session Agenda Item No. 14.c., both dealing with the extension of District services.
