SIDE LETTER OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GRATON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND THE GRATON PROFESSIONAL FIREFIGHTERS, LOCAL 1401, REGARDING CHANGES TO SECTION 1245.10 HOLIDAYS

The agreement between the Graton Fire Protection District (District) and the Graton Professional Fire Fighters, Local 1401 (Local) regarding agreed upon changes to Section 1245.10 Holidays, of the MOU.

Section 1245.10 Holidays, currently states:

When an Employee works on a holiday, the day will be paid at the overtime rate.
