This Motion For Issuance of Peremptory Writ of Mandate came on for hearing October 25, 2022, at 8:30 a.m. in Department 17 of this court, the Honorable Bradford DeMeo presiding. On September 28, 2022, petitioner filed a Notice Of Motion And Motion For Issuance of Peremptory Writ of Mandate. Petitioner, in her motion for writ, requested the following relief:

- A peremptory writ of mandate issue under seal of this court commanding respondent
   Graton Fire Protection District to comply with the California Public Records Act by
   producing any and all non-exempt records requested in petitioner's October 20, 2021 PRA
   request (Exhibit B, attached hereto.)
- A peremptory writ of mandate issue under seal of this court commanding respondent
   Graton Fire Protection District to comply with District Policy 1111.2 (Renumbered 1211.2)

   Personnel Complaints, by taking seriously and addressing petitioners August 6, 2021

complaint about Fire Chief Bullard's misrepresentations to the board and public regarding the "Resolution to Tax Defer Member Paid Contributions" in April and May of 2021.

At the end of the hearing this court ruled and denied petitioner's motion for issuance of writ as to issue number 2, and took under submission issue number 1. Neither party made a timely request for a statement of decision.

The court finds that petitioner has not met the burden necessary for the court to issue a writ of mandate on either issue.

After due consideration of all pleadings, declarations, evidence submitted and argument by the parties the court rules as follows:

The Motion For Issuance of Peremptory Writ of Mandate filed by petitioner in this matter is DENIED as to all relief requested therein.
